<u>MATTERS ARISING</u>: It was reported that repairs had been made to the road surface between Woodland Barton and Langford Cross. Highways had informed the Council that work would be carried out this week to complete the raised area near the Avon Inn. There has, so far, been a disappointing response to the advertisement for a Community Road Warden. This matter would be reviewed after the Diptford Parish Council meeting next week.

District Councillor Steer reported on the recent election to the District Council of a replacement Councillor for one who had retired. He informed the Council that appeals were being made against the refusal of planning consent for two wind turbines. The focus will initially be on Council business but this would be expanded to include other items of interest to parishioners at a later date.
