## **MINUTES SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AT THE NEXT MEETING**

Minutes of the meeting held on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2018 at St James's Church, Avonwick

### **OPEN FORUM:**

Members of the Primrose Trail Group outlined the aims and objectives of the group in trying to construct a cycle track/footpath from Kingsbridge to South Brent following, as far as possible, the track of the old railway line. Further news of this will be made available as work progresses. Concern was raised over the amount of litter along the Avonwick – Woodpecker road. Action clerk.

### **MATTERS ARISING:**

Cllr. Grevatt outlined the requirements of the new General Data Protection Regulation which comes into effect on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018. He is to establish what relevant data is held by the Council and what measures need to be undertaken to ensure that the Council complies with the Regulation. The clerk is to liaise with other local councils to see if there would be any advantage to be gained from the councils working together on this.

### **REPORTS:**

District Councillor Steer informed the Council that the Joint Local Plan had been put before the inspectors who deemed it to be basically sound. When put in place this plan will provide the basis for future development within the District. Councillor Steer wished to thank the local community for its positive spirit shown during the recent bad weather.
